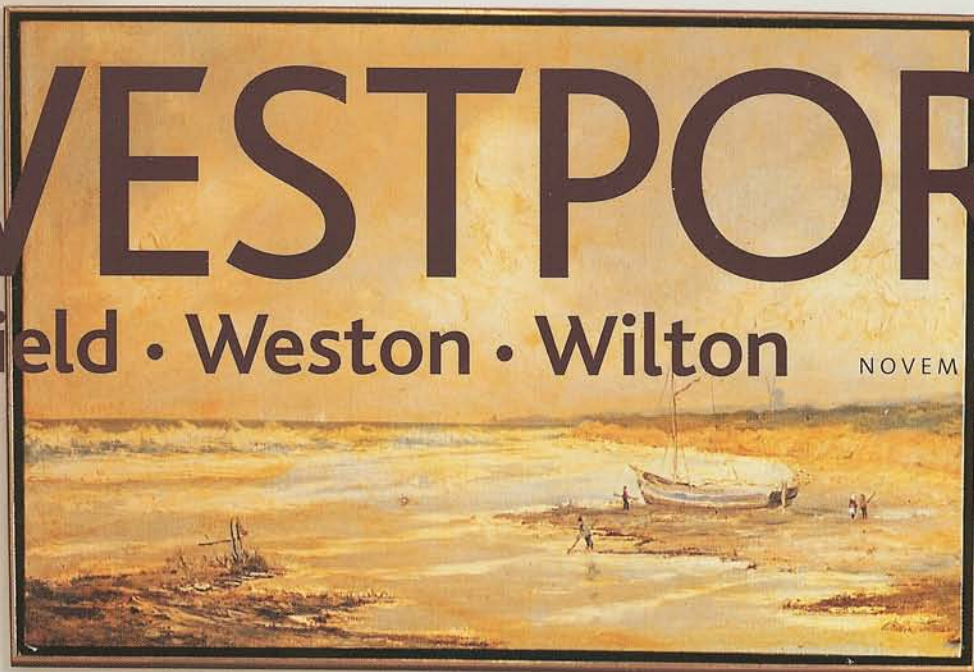

## Blue Moon

Fans of Simply Country on Rt. 7 in Wilton will be happy to learn that the shop has expanded its mix of antique and vintage furniture, lighting and other objects for the home. Also, the circa 1760 barn is now called **MOON HOLLOW**, but still under the ownership of Cindy Dunaway and her husband, Dennis (whom music fans might recognize as the Alice Cooper Band bassist). Cindy (who helped produce the rock band's shows) has a terrific eye for artisan-made pieces. "We're all about stars," says Cindy, who stocks the popular oversized, primitive-looking metal stars. Don't miss climbing the stairs to what was once the old hayloft, spilling over with antique textiles, from gold-embroidered table linens to kitschy fifties tea towels.
